Community Stalls – \$40.00 if paid by 31st January 2017. Late fee is \$65.00
Commercial Stalls - \$75.00 if paid by 31st January 2017. Late fee is \$100.00
Electricity (per connection) - \$10.00 (10 amps) or \$20.00 (over 10 amps)
Tent Hire - \$25.00 each

Community Food stall holders (fundraisers) do not need a DCC Environmental Health Form. Commercial Food Stalls should have the necessary paperwork. It is the Food Stall Holder's responsibility to adhere to the required health and safety standards for food preparation.

For those operating an amusement device you will need to obtain a **Permit to Operate an Amusement Device** from the Department of Labour.
